Venus's Looking Glass	<i>Specularia perfoliata</i>	yes	blue or violet
Yarrow	<i>Achillea millefolium</i>	?	white
St Johnswort, common	<i>Hypericum perforatum</i>	yes	yellow
Pearly Everlasting	<i>Anaphalis margaritacea</i>	yes	pearly-white
Horse Nettle	<i>Solanum carolinense</i>	yes	white or violet
Queen Anne's Lace	<i>Daucus carota</i>	no	white
Lesser Daisy Fleabane	<i>Erigeron strigosus</i>	yes	white

Clasping Milkweed	<i>Asclepias amplexicaulis</i>	yes	pink

Deptford Pink	<i>Dianthus armeria</i>	no	pink
Fleabane, Daisy	<i>Erigeron strigosus</i>	yes	white
Chinese Lespedeza	<i>Lespedeza cuneata</i>	no	creamy white
Sheep Sorrel	<i>Rumex acetosella</i>	no	reddish
<i>This section of the trail begins just inside the woods on the blue trail, goes to the reservoir and up the hill</i>			
Houstonia, Large	<i>Houstonia purpurea</i>	yes	purple
Bluets	<i>Houstonia caerulea</i>	yes	pale blue or white
Hairy Skullcap	<i>Scutellaria elliptica</i>	yes	blue
